Chartered by the state of Georgia in 1785, UGA is **the birthplace of public higher education** in America — launching our nation’s great tradition of world-class education for all. What began as a **commitment** to inspire the next generation grows stronger today through global research, hands-on experiential learning and extensive outreach. One of America’s “**Public Ivies,**” the University of Georgia tackles some of the world’s grand challenges — from combating infectious disease and securing the world’s food supply to advancing economic growth and analyzing the environment.

Located in Athens, **Georgia’s flagship university** boasts 17 schools and colleges that educate more than **36,000 students** each year and have graduated more than **318,000 alumni** who are now living around the world. The university offers **25 baccalaureate degrees in 170 fields** as well as a range of graduate and professional degrees, and it is also home to the Augusta University/University of Georgia Medical Partnership. Approximately an hour northeast of Atlanta, UGA thrives in a community that promotes the benefits of a **culture-rich college town** with a strong economic center.
