BECOME A MENTOR

WHAT IS THE UGA MENTOR PROGRAM?

The UGA Mentor Program is a free, student-driven platform open to all students — undergraduate, graduate, and professional — who are looking to make meaningful connections with alumni, faculty, staff, and friends of the University.

WHAT IS THE COMMITMENT?

Being a mentor means offering guidance and feedback to your mentee, helping establish clear expectations for the connection, and committing to the full length of time for the connection.

PATHS TO CONNECTION:

16 - Week Mentorship: a one-on-one connection with a student over 4 months. You will meet with your mentee multiple times during the course of the connection for approximately an hour/session.

Circles of Success: you will meet with a group of between 2-8 students for the duration of 16 weeks. Mentors opt into this experience through a link on their profiles.

Quick Chats: a one-time, 15-30 minute conversation with a mentee.

HOW TO GET STARTED:

Create a Profile: head to mentor.uga.edu to create a robust profile highlighting your professional experiences and lessons learned. Be sure to include a professional photo, a thorough professional summary, and any additional ways you would like to be engaged, such as through panels or virtual programming.

Connect from Anywhere: with the option to connect virtually or in-person, vou can make your mentorship fit into your busy schedule.
